Verify the firmware version (v2.1.4 or later supports FLAC streaming)

Upgrade Potential

Pair it with modern streaming devices via optical input - we've seen users combine it with Chromecast Audio for a retro-futuristic setup that outshines many \$1,000+ systems. One Reddit user reported: "My Spotify playlists never sounded this alive, and I'm using Grandma's old bookshelf speakers!"
